

These are the project choices the children have for the the summer reading program.

- **Character Hangings:** Make a paper head of a main character. Cut out some big circles and on each circle, write something about the character. For example: the title of the story the character was in, what the character looked like, tell whether you would be interested in knowing the character and why. A hole should be punched in the middle of the top and bottom circles and head. Tie together with yarn or string.
- **Bookmarks:** Make a bookmark about the story you have read. Include, **on the bookmark**, the title and author of the book, plus a summary of what happened in the book.
- **Masks:** Choose a character from the book and make a mask of it. Cut out the eyes. Decorate your mask. Be creative and use extras such as buttons, noodles, crepe paper, or anything that is available.
- **Book Mobiles:** Cut out, at the least, four shapes. They can be a shape idea from the book or the traditional shapes. Use the following four ideas (one for each shape) to tell about your book.
 - 1. Title of book
 - 2. Choose a character to tell about
 - 3. Summarize the book
 - 4. Tell the reason you liked the book.
