1. Create a Power Point Presentation and save to a disk. (Example of slides below)

<i>Slide One: Title Author Your Name School</i>	<i>Slide Two: Setting *Include what you know about the season, year, place, etc.</i>	<i>Slide Three: Characters: *Describe each character</i>	<i>Slide Four: Problem *State the problem(s) of the story in paragraph form</i>

2. Create a cereal box book report.
Cover a box with paper and then decorate the sides with these story elements:

one side panel: paragraph describing the main character
box back: brief summary of the book, drawing of the prize in the box that is an important item from the book
