Projects

1. Create a Power Point Presentation and save to a disk. (Example of slides below)

Slide One: Title Author Your Name School	Slide Two: Setting *Include what you know about the season, year, place, etc.	Slide Three: Characters: *Describe each character	Slide Four: Problem *State the problem(s) of the story in paragraph form
Slide Five: Important Events *Beginning	Slide Six: Important Events *Middle	Slide Seven: Important Events *End	Slide Eight: Resolution *In paragraph form

2. Create a cereal box book report.

Cover a box with paper and then decorate the sides with these story elements:

box front: book's title and author, a made-up cereal name that relates to the book, illustration of a bowl of the cereal,

student's name

one side panel: paragraph describing the main character

box back: brief summary of the book, drawing of the prize in the box that is an important item from the book

3. Create a poster. Your poster must include the following:

Title and author of the book.

Illustration must depict the main theme of the story.

Poster must be colorful and have no white showing.

4. Create a Song from your favorite book!

This is a creative way to show off your voice as well as writing skills.

Your song must include title of book and author.

Your song must include characters names

One to two verses must give brief summary of story

Sing to an already well known song, replacing lyrics

Example: Sung to tune of Mary Had a Little Lamb
